Agenda Item	Your Role	Questions for Mentee
Introductions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Name, Role, Location, Background & journey (how did you land your current role), Alteryx experience, goals - Share your goals as a mentor, and what you hope to accomplish 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What brought you to the mentorship program? • Tell me about yourself (background, experience, hobbies, etc.)
Goal Setting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand the mentee’s goals and how you can support them as a mentor (Career awareness, academic projects, professional goal setting, skill-building, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What goals do you want to accomplish as a mentee? • As a mentor, how can I best support you? What are you hoping to gain?
Cadence & Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Determine meeting structure and cadence (Teams, Email, Revere) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How often do you want to meet? • If project oriented, what is the timeline? • How do you prefer to communicate?
Wrap-Up & Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Allow mentee to ask any questions they may have <p>General mentorship questions: mentor@alteryx.com</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do you have any questions about the program? • What can I clarify or provide more information about?
