I spoke with our lead developer for Sharepoint integration. He isn't sure why it's occurring and writing to document libraries isn't supported, but we came up with a good idea for a workaround. Could you please try writing the file to a temporary location, then executing a move command within a <u>workflow event</u> to move the file to Sharepoint?

Also, writing to Sharepoint Document Libraries would be a great feature to support. I recommend you post a request to the <u>Idea Exchange</u> to create traction.

You're correct in saying SP stores the document as a BLOB in its backend SQL Server database.

However, we need to understand why there are there 2 copies with 2 different version numbers with 1 write to SP.

1 difference in your test vs. ours is that the 2 versions are the same size at our site but they are different size at your site, with  $2^{nd}$  file much smaller.



### Hi Andrew,

I was able to access a Sharepoint 2013 testing site and observe the same behavior (I saw the same behavior in SP2016)...



One of my thoughts is that it has something to do with how Sharepoint treats the document library - it's actually a blob object stored in MS SQL (I believe). When we save to a document library, perhaps the secondary modification is Sharepoint updating the SQL database. I'll reach out internally for more information about why this behavior might be occurring.




The attached workflow has an issue that it consistently writes duplicate output files to SharePoint. I need to understand what's causing the behavior (Alteryx setting or SP issue).
